
Re: WEEKLY INFO UPDATE

This Tuesday's City Council Meeting

We have a fairly light agenda Tuesday consisting mainly of consent agenda items and a special presentation by Code Enforcement Officer Mark Angelo reporting on the code enforcement cases and results of the new community outreach program.

TID BITS:

- We have begun the process to redesign the route of the Little Salt Wash Trail and found that our new route will enhance the trail experience south of the interstate.
- Appreciate Mayor Buck attending the press conference Monday with other Western Slope officials to oppose the Mayor's intent to use severance dollars in the state's general fund.
- Completed a successful first round of interviews for our next City Engineer this week.
- We have also received great applicants for our Planning Technician and hope to begin that process immediately.
- Police Department is conducting their processes for both a Police Officer and Animal Control positions.
- As a community, we diverted 9.24% of our waste through the curbside recycling program in 2014, which equates into 533.6 tons not sent to the landfill (attached is the Waste Management report).
- Couple great articles on the COOP this week regarding their expansion project and offering scholarships to high school graduates. (Attached is a thank-you we received from them).
- Below is also a thank-you from the Children's Nature Center for the City's donation.
- Enjoyed getting to know the leadership of both COPMOBA and the Colorado Canyons Association this week and look forward to continuing a solid partnership with these organizations.
- We are applying for a Colorado Water Conservation Board grant that requires no match to use Colorado Youth Corp (Western Colorado Conservation Corp) for about two weeks of work (\$15,000) to do Tamarisk, Russian olive or other invasive plant removal at Snooks Bottom.
- Night at the Fruita Community Center was a huge success last Friday with over 180 kids in attendance.
- Kidabaloo is coming to the Community Center Saturday Feb. 28th from 12 4 pm. Kidabaloo is advertised as "a fun-filled day all about play! It's



- highly interactive and an explosion of fun, laughter, and excitement." Special guest is Karan Brar "Ravi" from the Disney Channel show "Jessie" who will appear to the public from 2 pm 4 pm.
- The indoor pool at the FCC will be closed from 11:30 3:00 pm to replace two of the large lights above the pool with LED lights. This will be a test that hopefully results into replacing all the lights in the same manner.
- Staff is planning all the Mike Fest activities. A couple of new things in the works for this year are the Poultry Show with High Planes Poultry Club—expecting 200-300 birds (Did you know there is over 160 types of chickens out there?) The other is a showing of the movie *Back to the Future* at Alan's Unique Auto—they will also be displaying a real DeLorean during the festivities.
- Speaking of special events, FCI Constructors will be the sponsor for the Thursday Night Concert Series this summer.
- The slab under the mezzanine was poured this week at City Shops.
- Currently advertising for bids on the Ottley Ave. improvements project and the bid closing is February 13th.
- All Community Center staff met for training this past Sunday to review policies, the vision and mission of the center and train on emergency evacuations.
- Additional signage to add and keep the billboard fresh is being finalized to add advertising
 of the Dinosaur Journey Museum and events like the Fat Tire Festival that will rotate based
 on applicable timing.


