## **Tuesday's City Council Workshop**

On the agenda for the upcoming workshop are discussions about how the trial of a dog friendly area at the concerts has been, and the possibility of limited vendors at the concerts. I will also provide a brief overview of Jumpstart Colorado (SB 282), and Public Works Director Ken Haley will discuss the upcoming Downtown Streetscape Project.

### **Ride the Rockies**

The 2,000 cyclists and up to 750 support members that came through Fruita on Sunday seemed blown away by our community and its awesome volunteers. I want to thank our staff who worked so hard on this, the Chamber and their amazing efforts, our local businesses that accommodated the crowds so well while rearranging their hours and donating time and resources and all those who came out to volunteer and truly welcome these cyclists to Fruita!

#### **TID BITS:**

- The Fruita CO-op had a successful Grand Opening of its new additions this past Saturday for its \$4.5 million expansion of 12,800 square feet.
- Country Jam is bringing their wastewater to Fruita! In true last minute fashion, the sanitation company for the Country Jam event contacted staff on the first day of the event to explore whether they could dump the wastewater from the roughly 400 portable toilets at the City's Wastewater Plant. Fortunately, staff was able to work with them to figure out logistics of treating this quantity and type of wastewater. These services will require some additional expenses on the City's part, but they have agreed upon a price to cover these services.
- City Staff has received a CO on the new City Shop facility and plans to start moving into the new portion of the building next week. Once we are moved in, we plan on having an open house with tours of the new facility. Details to come!
- Speaking of open houses, the City will be hosting an open house on June 30<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 to 6:00 pm to gather public input on the proposed J.2 Road Improvements project.
