City Offices Closed Monday, February 20 in Observance of Presidents' Day.

Tuesday's City Council Meeting

The agenda is fairly light including an update on the new Trail Host Program among various consent agenda items.

TID BITS:

- 10th Annual Sweet Heart 5k/10k & Health Expo tomorrow!
- Lodging tax revenues were up 3.89% in 2016 compared to 2015, totaling \$110,845.
- City sales tax revenue was up 3.09% in 2016 compared to 2015.
- Use tax on building materials was up 93.87% in 2016 compared to 2015.
- Use tax on motor vehicles was down 3.59% in 2016 compared to 2015.
 County sales tax revenue was down 2.79% in 2016 compared to 2015.
- Staff has cleared quite a bit and surveyed the section of the Kokopelli section of the Riverfront Trail referred to as lot 3 we are going through the BLM process with.
- Began dirt work/grading at Snooks Bottom.
- The Laura-Pabor project has all sewer in west of Cedar—now working sewer from Cedar to the east towards Pine, which will be followed by irrigation. Limited traffic control is during working hours.
- HR completed our annual worker's comp audit.
- We are accepting applications for waste water operators.
- We are also conducting an internal recruitment process for Lieutenant and external process for Police Officers. The posting closed Thursday and we had 4 great applicants.
- Lt. Krouse is speaking at the Police Academy for the Ethics Panel.
- Staff met with Conservation Corps and they will be working more clean-up at Snooks Bottom March 1-9.
- We have been reaching out to Principals, FHW, etc. to kick-off the

- Communities that Care program with the Health Department.
- Crews have also been clearing/cleaning near the wastewater reclamation facility in preparation for trail construction.
- The Mayor and I were able to attend the surprise Milken Educator award to Rim Rock Elementary Teacher Felicia Casto (\$25,000) attended by the School Board, administrations, students and teachers at Rim Rock, the media and the state's Commissioner of Education.
- I attended the Conservation Colorado event Wednesday evening "Inside Scoop; Protecting our Environment for a Vibrant Community" that was well attended with the topics of public lands, economic development, outdoor recreation and tourism were focused on (Fruita receiving many kudos ©).
- I met with Family Health West and we decided to have details for a possible billboard lease agreement ready for the workshop.
- We hosted the AGNC Board meeting Wednesday at the Community Center that was well attended.
- Staff are working on which projects and grant cycles to seek this year.
- We will be hosting and speaking at the Mesa County Bicycling Alliance meeting on Feb. 27 at 6 pm at the Community Center.
- The Mayor, Lt. Krouse and I met with the county and municipalities continue discussions on addressing the rising costs at the Communication Center.
