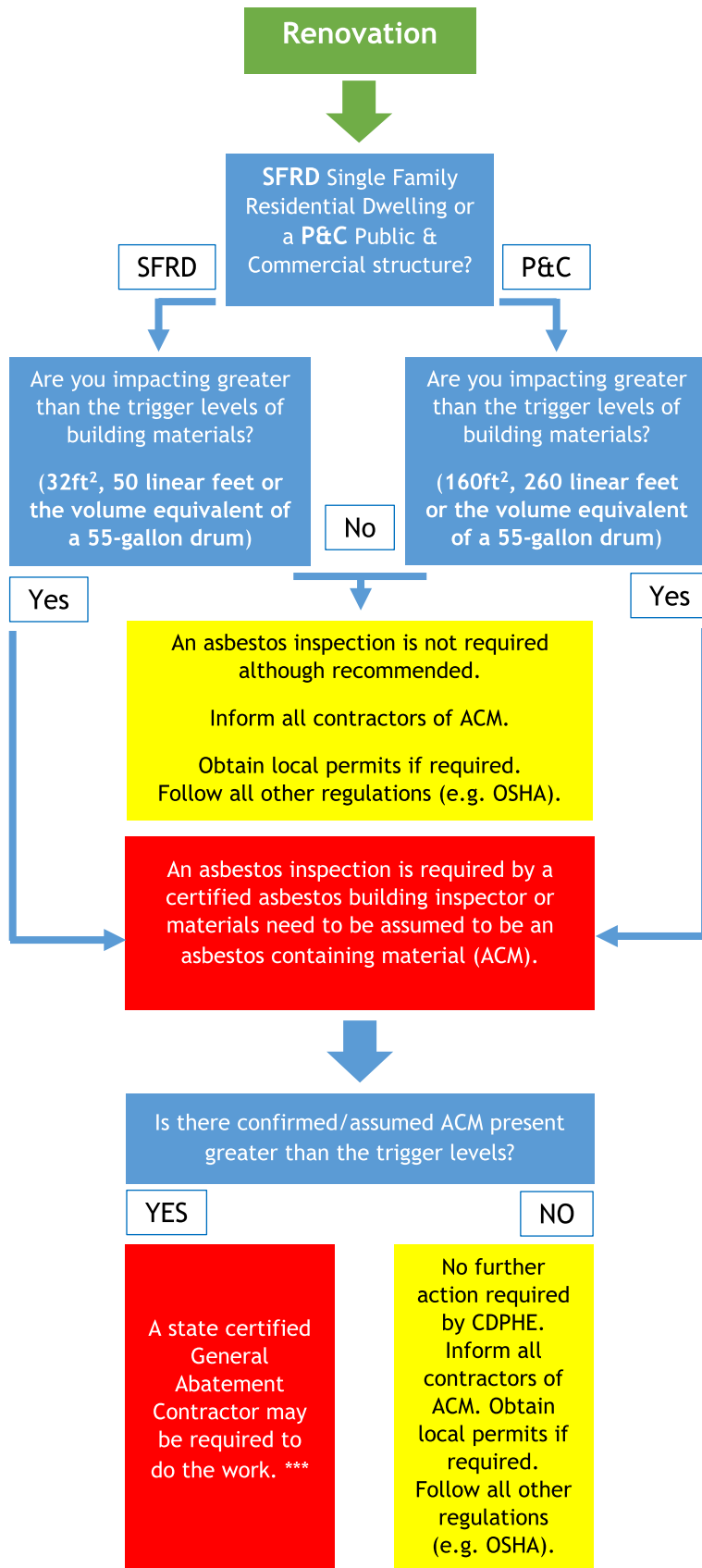


Is an Asbestos Inspection Required?



Demolition

Asbestos inspection & state demolition permit required. Asbestos inspection must be conducted by a certified asbestos building inspector.

Definitions and Links:

Renovation - Altering in any way one or more facility components. Examples of renovation work include, but are not limited to replacement or repair of mechanical ventilation systems, pipes, ceilings, walls, flooring (including floor tiles) and insulating materials

Demolition - The wrecking or taking out of any load-supporting structural member of a facility together with any related handling operations or the intentional burning of any facility.
