A RESOLUTION APPROVING A ONE-YEAR LEASE EXTENSION FOR A ROOM AT THE FRUITA CIVIC CENTER TO MESA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Fruita City Council and Mesa County entered into a Lease Agreement on February 1, 2019 for a room at the Fruita Civic Center located at 325 E Aspen, Fruita, CO for the purpose of motor vehicle registrations and related services, and

WHEREAS, the Lease Agreement will expire on December 31, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fruita and Mesa County desire to extend the lease for an additional one-year period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 pursuant to Article 9.1 of the Lease Agreement, and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 31-15-713 (1) (C) requires that lease agreements of less than one year be approved by resolution of the City Council.
