

Truck Route Definitions

Primary Truck Routes: These routes are to be used by trucks that have no origin or destination in the City of Fruita urban area.

Secondary Truck Routes: These routes are to be used by trucks that have an origin or destination within the City of Fruita urban area. Trucks that have an origin or destination within the urban area are requested to remain on these routes until reaching a point closest to their destination.




Hazardous Materials Routes: The Colorado State Patrol designates the following State Highways as Hazardous Materials Routes:
1. Interstate 70
2. State Highway 139

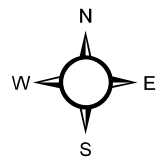
No other streets, roads, or highways within the City of Fruita area are designated as Hazardous Materials Routes.

Information: Per chapter 10.14 (Restricted Truck Routes) of the Fruita Municipal Code, trucks are restricted from using through traffic routes other than those designated hereon. For additional information and maps, contact the Colorado State Patrol at (970) 858-2250.
